



Communities Questions and Discussion

For the week of: **May 1, 2011**

1. What is your favorite movie, book or story? What about the story makes it so great to you? Is your favorite movie/story similar to your life story?
2. They call this age the "information age" because information is more widely available than it has ever been. How has the cultural expectation to know more things stopped you from sharing your story? How do we become more confident to share our stories? Read 2 Timothy 1:7-8 and discuss how we can encourage our community to become unstoppable.
3. Every Christian has a remarkable story! Do you enjoy telling your Christian story to others? What makes sharing your story with others difficult? How can we encourage our community to share their faith story?
4. Check out 1 Peter 3:15. If you were a believer who knew very little scripture or theology, what reason would you give others for the hope that you have? Would your story be enough? What makes your story unstoppable?
5. Recall the story about Jesus healing the blind man from John 9. Does the fact that the blind man knows little about *how* he was healed make his story any more or less miraculous? What are the similarities between your story and this man's story? What are the differences?
