- 1. In the last few weeks at OneLife, we've been talking about how your story makes you unstoppable for Jesus. Describe how sharing your story with others has helped you share Jesus with others. How has your story made you unstoppable?
- 2. Just like the servant in Luke 14:15-24, you might have experienced rejection or heard only excuses as you shared your story or invited others to church. How have you dealt with this rejection? Have you felt discouragement or have you been patient? Have you felt like God was asking you to move on or stay the course with a person?
- 3. How would you describe the attitude of the master in Luke 14:15-24? Is he desperate? Is he asking too much of his servant? How is the relationship of this master and servant like your relationship with God?
- 4. What reason did the master give his servant for wanting more people at his banquet (v.23)? Why should you want OneLife to be full? If you agree that God wants OneLife to be FULL, then what stops you from telling your story and convincing your friends that they should know Jesus, too?
- 5. It is interesting that the master invited people from all walks of life (vv. 16, 21, 23) the rich, the poor and then *everybody*! What kind of people do you feel most comfortable engaging with in spiritual conversation or extending an invitation to church? Rich? Poor? Needy? Just like you? Different than you?
