



## Communities Questions and Discussion

For the week of: **September 4, 2011**

Read Acts 15:1-11

1. How did last week's discussion about truly changing what you care about make a difference in how you lived your life or how you thought and prayed this week?
2. For as long as the church has been around, Christians have naturally gravitated toward disinfecting being more important than discipleship. Why do you think that is? How can you as an individual protect yourself from doing the same?
3. If OneLife is going to be a church that cares more about discipleship than disinfecting, what will be different? What will your personal role be in that? How does it change what you do on Sunday mornings?
4. Verse 10 says the view of "disinfecting" is challenging to God. Why do you think it is challenging to God? What does this say about God's top priority? What does it say about how God views people differently than we do?
5. Many people you will come in contact with will actually hold to the disinfecting view, thinking they have to get their "act together" before they give God a chance to change their life. How will this story help you communicate with them? What are some practical ways you can get people who aren't yet Christians to care more about becoming a disciple than getting disinfected?
