- 4. Has there been a time in your life when you decided to put your trust in God rather than in money. If so, what did that experience teach you about God?
- 5. Read 2 Corinthians 8:2-3. Jesus said it is more blessed to give than to receive. Describe a time you gave sacrificially and the affect it had on you. In these verses, even those who were living in "extreme poverty" were "richly generous." Is there any way you could give even more sacrificially? If so, what would it be? What luxuries could you do without to become more generous?
